Tasmanian Rally Championship Supplementary Regulations for the 2018 Les Walkden Enterprises Mountain Stages Rally

- 1.1 2018 Les Walkden Enterprises Mountain Stages Rally will be a CAMS State Championship Special Stage Rally, held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the National Competition Rules (NCR) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS), the National Rally Code (NRC), the Tasmanian Rally Championship Regulations (TRC), Tasmanian Rally Championship Sporting Regulations, these Event Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations or Bulletins issued.

The Rally will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S, CAMS Safety 1st and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au.

- 1.2 The CAMS Permit Number authorising the Event is 718/1310/01
- 1.3 Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the Event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook available at www.cams.com.au

Tasmanian Rally Championship Supplementary Regulations for the 2018 Les Walkden Enterprises Mountain Stages Rally

- 2.1 The 2018 Les Walkden Enterprises Mountain Stages Rally counts towards the following series:
- 2018 Tasmanian Rally Championship
 - 2018 Buckby Subaru RS Challenge
- 2.2 The total length of the Rally will be approximately 340 kms including 8 SpecialStages
The competitive length of the Rally will be approximately 175 kms
- 2.3 The Rally will consist of two heats on the one day. Competition in the second heat will be conditional on the vehicle having started in the first Heat but not necessarily finishing that heat.
- 2.4 The Start of the Rally will be at 1000 hrs on Saturday 13th October 2018 from TC0 (the Out Control) at the Mathinna Recreation Ground. Each Crew must report to this control in accordance with the Official Start List.

Article 3 Entry Form, Entries and Entry Fee

- 3.1 The Entry Fee for the 2018 Les Walkden Enterprises Mountain Stages Rally will be \$425 for Early Entries and \$495 for Late Entries. Early Entries fee WILL ONLY be accepted with FULL payment on or before the early entry date.

Each Competitor (entrant) must ensure compliance with the NCR in regard to their entry to the Rally.

Article 4 Servicing

- 4.1 The event will have a remote refuelling area in the last transport. Details of the remote refuelling will be detailed in a subsequent bulletin.
- 4.2 Servicing may only be carried out at the Mathinna Service Area. Servicing is not permitted at the remote refuel area.

Article 5 Documentation and Scrutiny

- 5.1 Pre-event Scrutiny is compulsory for each vehicle entered into the Rally.
Scrutiny locations and times will be provided in an event bulletin after the close of entries.
- 5.2 Please present the following documentation at Scrutiny:
Minimum CAMS Clubman Rally (CR) or CAMS Clubman Rally Navigator (CRN)
Civil Driver's Licence
CAMS Log Book (if issued)

Article 6 Refusal of Entry

The Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 83 of current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

Article 7 Protests

All Protests must be lodged in accordance with the provisions of Part XII of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport

Article 8 Abandonment, Postponement of Cancellation

The Organisers reserve the right to abandon the event in accordance with the provisions of NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

Article 9 Alcohol, Drugs and other Substances

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.
