## Disclaimer

## **PUBLIC INSTRUCTIONS**

*(please read)*

### **1. COVID – 19**

**You will need to provide your contact details to one of our Officials on arrival at the Spectator Point.**

**Please ensure you maintain the physical distancing where possible.**

**Wash your hands.**

**Use the sanitiser that is provided.**

**Should you develop any symptoms – get tested.**

**2. Public are directed to view the cars whilst standing within the markers indicating the limits of the controlled public area- spectating outside those area indicated is prohibited.**

**3. Public must not stand in prohibited areas, and must at all times stand behind the bunting or barriers which mark the public area.**

**4. The instructions of the Spectator Marshals must be obeyed. The Spectator Marshal has the power to have a stage postponed until the Public View Point is controlled to his/her satisfaction.**

**5. It is prohibited to ignore the public instructions and find your own way around. Not only is there a danger of meeting up with an oncoming rally vehicle, but many roads have wash-aways, collapsed bridges, etc. which are potentially hazardous for the driver. The main public route has been surveyed and is safe.**

## DO'S AND DONT'S OF SPECTATING

*(Please read)*

1. Cars under competition conditions can lose control and leave the defined road at any time. Do not stand in any areas which are not authorised or which are contrary to the advice of the organisers and officials/marshals.
2. Be prepared. Weather wise, bring hats, ground cover, sun screen and protection in case of rain or cold weather. Food and drink outlets may be provided at the Public View Point (refer to public instructions), but if not, ensure you have some of your own food and drinks available.
3. Park your car sensibly so that it will not obstruct emergency vehicles, competitors, service crews or other members of the public. In all cases obey parking instructions given by supervising officials. It is usually best to park your car facing the way out.
4. Do not try to emulate rally drivers. Remember that if you give cause for complaint it will reflect badly on the rally and the sport as a whole. Drive carefully both to and from public viewing areas, and be ready to give way if necessary on narrow stretches of road.
5. Please do not take dogs or young children to Public View Points. If you have to, make sure they are completely under your control and please make sure that animals and children do not get in the way of competing cars or mechanics or officials when they are working.
6. Do not light fires or smoke in the forests. Do not smoke near a car that is being serviced or refueled.
7. At all times keep clear of controls, including from the timing marker to the control area. If control officials ask you to move, please help them by doing so - remember they have a job to do which can be difficult enough as it is. If you do want to see a control point in action, remember to stand well back from the control area.
8. Take your entire litter home with you - it is handy to have a bag or carton in your boot. Cans and paper do not help beautify our forests.
9. At service points do not crowd mechanics when they are working. They would not appreciate it. Neither will you if someone drops a wheel or a sump guard on your foot!



## **Spectator Instructions – CJR Enterprises Rocky Cape Sprint Rally**

**Tipunah Road “four ways”. A great spot located approximately 16km South of Forest township.  
The cars are here 2 separate times in different directions on each occasion.**

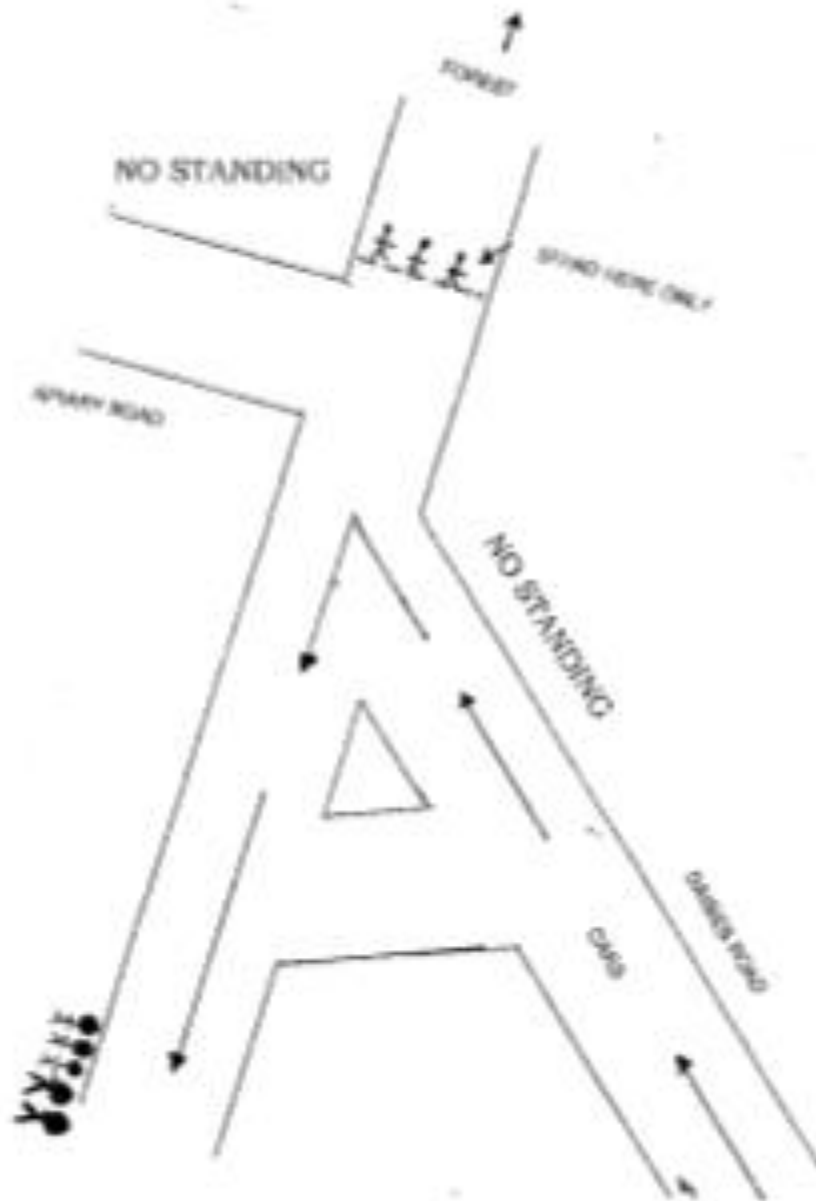
### **How to get there.**

1. Find your way to Forest township.
2. From Forest head south (away from Bass Strait) on Mengha Road.
3. Go past Murrays Lane (on LHS).
4. Go past Ringle Doddy Road (on LHS).
5. Go past Spion Kop Road (on LHS).
6. Go past Twin Creeks Road (on LHS).
7. After 4.9 kms **Turn left into Tierneys Road.**
8. It is all gravel from here and there will be 2 way traffic.
9. Follow main gravel road for 2.7 kms.
10. After 2.7 kms turn left onto Tipunah Road.
11. Follow Tipunah Road (do not take any spur roads – after 2 kms there is an unnamed spur on LHS.  
Keep right and follow main road) for a total of 8.5 kms and you will arrive at Spectator Point.  
Caution, this road is sometimes narrow, has loose gravel and blind crests. Drive sensibly.
12. Park sensibly and please take any rubbish with you when you leave.
13. Cars will approach from Daisies Road then turn very hard left uphill.
14. Good safe viewing from up the road after the turn on the side track on the right hand side of the road.
15. 1st car due at 11.55 am and next ones are 2 minutes apart. This is Special stage 2 of 8.
16. Cars will return from the same direction at 2.30pm on Special Stage 5 after Major service.
